Earlier, ICAR has requested the Government of Uttar Pradesh to allot 150 acres of land for its establishment which was approved by the Cabinet chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research also formed a high level committee to look after the transfer formalities and other related issues. The committee after a detailed discussion has recommended for the acquisition of land and consequently the Dr. A.K. Mohanty Director of the Institute has taken over the land.
